Crondall Bowls Club -Mentors Responsibilities



A mentor is a club member who informally guides a less experienced person during their introductory period. A mentor should always have the mentee's best interests in mind and tailor their mentorship style to meet that person's needs.

The mentor should:

- 1) Ensure that the mentee is made welcome at all times
- 2) Show the mentee around the Pavilion, indicating where and what information is available.
- 3) Show the mentee around the rinks and the equipment sheds
- 4) Encourage the mentee to take a full part in all Club activities, ensuring they are familiar with the processes and procedures including:
 - a) club competitions,
 - b) availability for friendly matches,
 - c) roll up sessions,
 - d) access codes,
 - e) setting up for games,
 - f) tea Rota,
 - g) club clothing,
 - h) social events
 - i) Special events such as President's Day & Chairman's Trophy
 - j) Presentation Dinner
 - k) Supporting activities such as maintenance of the green & surrounds
